Description

A Crocodile & Silver cigar Case by Corke Brothers of London.

The cigar case is a standard design of one sleeve fitting inside the other to allow you to extend the length depending on the cigars. The case stands out though both its use of crocodile skin and the silver lip to the outer sleeve. It is held by three rivets to each side and hallmarked for London 1905. It is also stamped with the maker's mark that was used by Corke Brothers between 1904 and 1912. They are an interesting company and more can be read on them by clicking the link to their name to the top right of the screen.

At sometime the case been damaged to the bottom of the outer part. It has been repaired, is stable and perfectly useable. This cigar case was made as a luxury item using both crocodile and silver to enhance it. Hallmarked for London 1905.
