Description

The two heavy glass bottles of this travelling decanter set have silver screw on caps, hallmarked for London 1903.

The caps also have the maker's initials of GB and have a cork lining to make the bottles watertight. They sit in a leather hide travel case with a fish tail handle to the top and a singular tooled decoration line. These are a good pair of decanters that don't take up much space when packed. Dated 1903.
